# CROOKED CREEK HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

### Signage and General:

- 1. Please adhere to all signs both permanent and temporary posted around the park including but not limited to speed limits, no smoking/fires, no horses, no pets, no parking etc.
- 2. No parking/camping within 20 feet of any building or structure. No exceptions.
- 3. No electrical cords running across roads or out of barns.
- 4. **No** Alcohol. Alcohol is prohibited on the CCHP property or on trails.
- 5. Place all trash in lined trash receptacles or in dumpsters.
- 6. You assume all risk associated with equine activities pursuant to Pennsylvania Law. For more information please go to: <a href="https://www.pennsylvaniaequinecouncil.org">www.pennsylvaniaequinecouncil.org</a> or call 1-888-304-0281

#### Fires and Smoking:

- 7. **No** smoking or fires in/under any building or structure.
- 8. No camp fires by structures. Keep camp fires a minimum of 20 feet from all buildings.
- 9. No unattended fires. Please ensure all fires are completely extinguished when unattended and prior to leaving the grounds.

#### Pets:

- 10. Pets MUST be leashed and under control at all times. You will be liable for any and all damages or harm caused by your pet.
- 11. <u>No</u> pets in restrooms, shower facilities, kitchen, and administration building. Pets are prohibited in these areas.
- 12. <u>No</u> pets in stalls or tied to structures unattended. Pets in campsites must not infringe on neighboring campsites.
- 13. Please dispose of bagged solid pet waste in lined trash receptacles or dumpster.

#### Horses:

- 14. <u>No</u> Horses in the picnic area by the administration building, all walkways around the arena, the graveled parking area behind the bleachers, and in all hookup camping sites. Horses are prohibited from these areas at all times.
- 15. No tying horses to trees at any time.
- 16. <u>No</u> picketing, tying, or corralling of horses in hookup campsites, pavilions or on trail surfaces. Use primitive camping locations for these containment methods.
- 17. Manure, hay, and other horse wastes, including piles at primitive sites, must be dumped in manure pits including piles at primitive campsites.
- 18. Stall reservations must be made in advance.

## Camping and Vehicles:

- 19. No camping in stalls, barns, or pavilions.
- 20. Generators must be turned off from 11pm to 6am.
- 21. No parking within 20 feet buildings and structures. All structures must have 20 feet clearance to comply with fire regulations.
- 22. Speed limit is 5mph throughout the park at all times for all vehicles.
- 23. Motorbikes, quads, golf carts, UTVs and similar vehicles should be used with caution and courtesy. <u>No</u> vehicles are permitted on the trails without special permit.
- 24. If unloading a horse near a barn, please do so quickly and move your rig to its designated area.
- 25. No discharge of "gray water" and/or "sanitary water" from campers at anytime.
- 26. We are NOT associated with Crooked Creek State Park. Use of their disposal facility must be arranged by you with them at their fee and discretion.
- 27. No overloading electrical hookups. Please confirm the amps of your hookup site and your trailer prior to connection.
- 28. All fees must be paid to show producer during events. During non-events or days prior to rental agreements, all standard daily fees for camping and stalls apply and must be paid in advance to FAHA or via dropbox.
- 29. No marking/blocking of campsites unless full daily fees are paid for each day the site is physically blocked.
- 30. No primitive camping in hookup sites. Full hookup site fees must be paid regardless of use of hookups in hookup locations.
